Promotes the Oratorical Program for the Department of California for several years and at all levels of the Department in Area 4.


Area 5 Commissioner



How to Plan an Oratorical Contest

What is needed to Conduct a Contest

- All documents required per National standards and an understanding of contest paperwork requirements
- School contact can be home schooled, parochial, magnet, etc.
- Legion Post and District willing to participate and follow requirements
- Location that complies with contest needs
- Scheduling date in compliance with District, Area, and Department timeline
- Participants that have had a background check when required per Department guidelines

What is needed to Conduct a Contest

- Certificates for presentation to the participating students (others are optional)
- First, Second, and Third Oratorical medals (if needed)
- Monetary prizes based on ability to give
- Food and beverages for participants and guests

What Forms/Booklets are Required

- National Program Chairman's Guide
- National HS Oratorical Scholarship Program Brochure
- National HS Oratorical Scholarship Official Rules
- National HS Oratorical Scholarship one page flyer
- Copy of the Declaration of Independence and The Constitution of the United States of America (As Amended)
- Risk Management Guidebook
- W-9 for each student
- Department of California Oratorical Contestant Participation Pledge Form

What Forms/Booklets are Required

- Judges Briefing, Excel Tabulation Spreadsheet, Excel Judges Spreadsheet
- Prepared and Assigned Oration Scratch Talley Sheets
- Judge Scorecard
- Written Responsibilities for Timekeepers, Escorts, Ushers, Assigned Topic Prep Room Monitor, Tabulators, Judges
- Current year's Prepared and Assigned Topics

Miscellaneous Items to Support Contest

- Flyers for notification of the event
- Event Program
- Signage for holding rooms, arrows to event room, and silence
- Stop watches or cell phones with knowledgeable operators
- Numbering system for identifying contestants
- Laptop to compute scores with knowledgeable operators
- Finger foods and beverages optional (No Alcohol)
